Materials used:

YarnArt Jeans, color 47 - blue, for a suit

YarnArt Jeans, color 15 - light gray, for head and fingers

YarnArt Jeans, color 68 - grey, suit details

YarnArt Jeans, color 33 - blue, for hair

YarnArt Jeans, color 76 - turquoise, for boots

Yarn Alize Cotton Gold, color 493 - brown, for the emblem

Hook: main 2mm; 1.75mm; 1.25mm (crochet 2mm if not other number given)

Wire for the frame, optional

To attach the head, thick wire, or a pencil, or cotton sticks

Some cardboard for the insoles

Filler

Electrical tape or adhesive tape

white cloth

Acrylic paints for fabric

Scissors

Long sewing needle

Clay Moment Crystal

The height of the toy, subject to the use of the indicated materials, is 24 cm.

For knitting toys, you can use any yarn and suitable for her hook. Depending on the thickness of the yarn and the density of knitting, the size toys may vary.

Abbreviations:

sc - single crochet

psn - half-column with a crochet

ssn - double crochet

ss2n - double crochet

convex sc - single crochet, knitted from right to left for

column of the previous row

concave sc - single crochet, knitted from right to left in front

column of the previous row

vp - air loop – ch:chain

pr - increase

ub - decrease

ss - connecting column

\* - number of repetitions

Arms

Fingers (hook 1.75; color 15; 10 pieces)

1) 5 sc in KA (5)

2 - 5) 5 sc (5)

We connect the fingers (hook 2; color 68)

1) 2 sbn on the 1st, 2 sbn on the 2nd, 2 sbn on the 3rd, 5 sbn on 4-mu, 3 sb on the 3rd, 3 sb on the 2nd, 3 sb on the 1st (20)

2) For the left hand: 2 sc, 2 sc along with the 5th, 16 sc (twenty)

For the right hand: 6 sc, 2 sc along with the 5th, 12 sc (20)

3) For the left hand: 2 sc, 3 sc with the 5th, 15 sc (20)

For the right hand: 5 sc, 3 sc with the 5th, 12 sc (20)

4) (8 sc, dec) \* 2 (18)

5) (7 sbn, ub) \* 2 (16)

6) (6 sc, dec) \* 2 (14)

7) (5 sc, dec) \* 2 (12)

8) (4 sc, dec) \* 2 (10)

Do not cut the thread, bring it forward

If your toy will be on a frame, insert wire, after wrapping it with electrical tape or plaster.

Fill the brush with filler. Next, fill the pen asknitting.

Attach blue thread

9) For the rear half loops 10 sc (10)

10) 10 sc (10)

11) For the back half loops 10 sc (10)

12 - 13) 10 sc (10)

14) for the front half loops 10 sc (10)

15 - 16) 10 sc (10)

Turn sleeve inside out

17) connect the inverted edge with the front half loops 11 row.

Cut the thread.

Attach the thread to the back half loops of the 14th row.

18) 10 sbn for the back loops of 14 rows (10)

Repeat rows 11-18 3 more times. On the fourth gate 18 row do not knit.

Do not leave a thread for sewing, hands will be tied into body.

Legs

start turquoise

1) 5 ch, in the second air loop from the hook: inc, 2 sc,  
3 sc in one loop, 3 sc (10)

2) 2 inc, 2 sc, 3 inc, 2 sc, inc (16)

3) (sc, inc) \* 2, 2 sc, (sc, inc) \* 3, 3 sc, inc (22)

4) For the back half-loop 22 sc (22)

Change thread to gray

5) For the back half-loop 22 sc (22)

6) 22 sc (22)

Insert insole

7) 7 sc, 4 dec, 7 sc (18)

8) 5 sc, 3 dec, 7 sc (15)

Change thread to blue

9) For the back half-loop 15 sc (15)

For a toy on a frame, insert a wire. Hit the foot.

10 - 18) 15 sc (15)

Stuff the leg as you knit.

We return to the 9th row, attach the turquoise thread to the side in the middle and knit:

1) ss, sbn, psn, pr ssn, psn, 2 ss, sbn, psn, 2 inc ssn, psn, sbn, ss

2) ss, sbn, psn, 2 inc ss, psn, 2 ss, sbn, psn, 4 ss, psn, sb, ss

Cut the thread on the first leg, do not cut the second leg, we continue to knit the body.

Body

1) Knit another 7 sc on the second leg, dial 3 ch and

attach the first leg: 15 sc, 3 sc in ch, 15 sc, 3 sc in ch (36)

2 - 16) 36 sc (36)

In the next two rows we knit hands. If in your

If the arms are not on the side, correct the number columns in a row.

17) 7 sbn, 5 sbn together with the hand, 13 sbn, 5 sbn together with hand, 6 sc (36)

18) 7 sbn, 5 sbn together with the hand, 13 sbn, 5 sbn together with hand, 6 sc (36)

19) (4 sc, dec) \* 6 (30)

20) (3 sc, dec) \* 6 (24)

21) (2 sc, dec) \* 6 (18)

If the toy is on a frame, connect the wire of the arms and legs tape or plaster, and hang out the long end of the wire for the head.

22) (1 sc, dec) \* 6 (12)

23) for the back half loops 4 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, sc (14)

24 - 26) 14 sc (14)

27) for the front half loops 14 sc (14)

28 - 30) 14 sc (14)

Turn outward and knit the connecting posts behind front half loops of the 23rd row.

We knit the details of the costume

Wrist band, color 15 (2 pcs) ch 6 Dec, sb, dec

Leave the thread for sewing.

Knee pads and belt buckle, turquoise (2 pcs) 6 sc in KA, sl-st

Leave the thread for sewing.

Stripes for shoes, turquoise (2 pcs.) ch 11 10cc

Leave the thread for sewing.

Leg stripes, color 68: upper (2 pcs.) ch 13 12 ss lower (2 pcs.) ch 10 9 ss

Leave the thread for sewing.

Belt, color 68 ch 41 40 sc

Leave the thread for sewing.

The second part of the belt that runs between the legs. color 68

ch 3, turn knitting after each row 1 - 14) 2 sc

Leave the thread for sewing.

Pocket, color 68 1st detail: ch 8, then knit in turning rows

1 - 2) 7 sc

2nd detail: ch 8, then knit in turning rows

1 - 2) 7 sc

At the bottom, knit a row with a crustacean step

Leave the thread for sewing.

The basis for the emblem (alize cotton gold yarn, from the main separate two threads and crochet them 1.25)

1) 6 sc in KA

2) 6 inc (12)

3) (sbn, inc) \* 6 (18)

4) (2 sc, inc) \* 6 (24)

5) (3 sc, inc) \* 6 (30)

2 ss

Leave a long tail for sewing.

Emblem mount

1st detail: turquoise

4 ch, then turning rows

1 - 3) 3 sc

We tie straps to this part from four sides, in color 68 without breaking the thread.

Upper: attach the thread to the upper right side, to the 3rd sc, knit 13 ch, return 12 sc, sl-st to the 1st sc of the edge.

We dial 13 ch, return 12 sc, sl-st to the edge.

Lower: 17 ch, return 16 sc, sl-st to the edge.

We dial 17 ch, return 16 sc, sl-st to the edge.

Leave the thread for sewing.

Decorate Nolik's body based on the photo.



#### Head

1) 6 sc in KA (6)

2) Pr\*6 times (12)

3) (sbn, inc) \* 6 (18)

4) (2 sc, inc) \* 6 (24)

5) (3 sc, inc) \* 6 (30)

6) (4 sc, inc) \* 6 (36)

7) (5 sc, inc) \* 6 (42)

8) (6 sc, inc) \* 6 (48)

9) (7 sbn, inc) \* 6 (54)

10-18) 54 sc (54)

19) 25 sc, inc, 2 sc, inc, 25 sc (56)

20) 17 sc, (inc, sc) \* 4, 2 inc, 2 sc, 2 inc, (sc, inc) \* 4, 17 sc (68)

21) 17 sc, (inc, 2 sc) \* 4, 10 sc, (2 sc, inc) \* 4, 17 sc (76)

22) 33 sb, for the back half loops 5 dec, 33 sb (71)

23) 33 sc, dec, sc, dec, 33 sc (69)

24) 69 sc (69)

25) (22 sc, dec) \* 3 (66)

26) (9 sbn, dec) \* 6 (60)

27) (8 sc, dec) \* 6 (54)

28) (7 sc, dec) \* 6 (48)

29) (6 sc, dec) \* 6 (42)

30) (5 sc, dec) \* 6 (36)

31) (4 sc, dec) \* 6 (30)

Stuff your head with stuffing, paying special attention to the snout and cheeks.

32) (3 sc, dec) \* 6 (24)

33) (2 sc, dec) \* 6 (18)

34) (sbn, dec) \* 6 (12)

35-36) 12 sc (12)

Leave a long end for sewing.

We do a stretch. Mark a place for a smile, approximately between 24 and 25 rows. Mark a place for tightening the eyes between 18 and 19 in rows, the distance between the marks is 4 sc. Insert the needle into the left corner of a smile and draw in the left corner of the left eye, then insert the needle into the right corner of the left eye and withdraw into the left corner of the smile, stepping back from the mark to the right one sc. Repeat tightening again, fasten the thread.

For the second eye, repeat the same steps.

## Wig

Knit behind the back half loops

1) 6 sc in KA (6)

2) Pr\*6 (12)

3) (sbn, inc) \* 6 (18)

4) (2 sc, inc) \* 6 (24)

5) (3 sc, inc) \* 6 (30)



6) (4 sc, inc) \* 6 (36)

7) (5 sc, inc) \* 6 (42)

8) (6 sc, inc) \* 6 (48)

9) (7 sbn, inc) \* 6 (54)

10-13) 54 sc (54)

14) 35 sc, rotate

15) for the front half-loops 35 sc, turn

16) for the back half loops: dec, 31 sc, dec (33)

17) turn, for the front half loops: dec, 29 sc, dec (31)

18) turn, behind the rear half loops: dec, 27 sc, dec (29)

19) turn, for the front half loops: dec, 25 sc, dec (27)

20) turn, ch 3, slst2n, prs, psn, prs, 2 slst.

Cut the thread. Attach the thread on the other side to the edge wig and repeat row 20.

We form a hairstyle.

We attach each cell to the front half loops of the wig.

We knit in turning rows. We fill the cells a little filler. For each cell, we reattach the thread and cut at the end.

We start with the front row.

First we knit the middle cell. Count down five columns, in the sixth we introduce a hook:

1) 2 sl-st, 2 prs, 2 prs, 2 prs. We knit according to the last dc down 2 sc. Ss for the front half-loop of the wig, turn

2) for the front half-loops 10 sc, sl-st for the wig, turn

3) 8 sc, 1 convex sc, inc, sl-st per wig, turn (11)

4) 2 sc, 1 concave sc, 8 sc, sl-st per wig, turn (11)

5) 8 sbn, 1 convex sbn, sbn, inc, ss per wig, turn (12)

6) We knit for the front half loops and each column attach to the wig.

Skip 3 sc, 2 sc2n, 2 sc, 2 sc, 2 sc

From the middle cell we knit two more cells to the left and to the right according to the following scheme:

1) ss, 2 sbn, 2 psn. On the last dc we knit down 1 sbn. Ss for the front half-loop of the wig, turn

2) for the front half-loops 6 sc, sl-st for the wig, turn

3) 4 sc, 1 convex sc, inc, sl-st per wig, turn (7)

4) 2 sc, 1 concave sc, 4 sc, sl-st per wig, turn (7)

5) 4 sbn, 1 convex sbn, sbn, inc, ss per wig, turn (eight)

6) We knit for the front half loops and each column attach to the wig.

Skip 3 sc, 2 dc, psn, sb, ss

To the second cells from the middle, down, we bind the following:

Attach the thread for the remaining half loops of the 2nd row, so so that the decreases are from the side of the face, and attach each row to the half loops of the wig from the side of the head.

1) 5 sc, sl-st per wig, turn (5)

2) 3 sc, dec, turn (4)

3) 4 sc, sl-st per wig, turn (4)

4) 2 sc, dec, turn (3)

5) dec, sc, slst per wig, turn (2)

6) ub, ss per wig (1)

Continue to knit three more cells on the back of the head according to the scheme middle cell.

At the back of the head, knit 4 cells at the bottom according to the following pattern:

1) Attach the thread to the front half loops of the bottom row

6 sc, sl-st per wig, turn (6)

2) inc, 5 sc, sl-st per wig, turn (7)

3) 5 sbn, 1 convex sbn, inc, ss for the wig, turn (8)

4) 2 sc, 1 concave sc, 5 sc, sl-st per wig, turn (8)

5) 5 sbn, 1 convex sbn, 2 sbn, sl-st for the wig, turn (8)

6) Knit for the front half loops, each column attach to the half loops of the wig: 2 dc, 2 dc, sb, ss

We knit three rows of the crown, starting from the front row to the center.

The first row - 7 cells according to the following scheme:

1) sl-st, 2 prs, 2 prs, 2 prs, 2 prs down the last prs, sl-st behind wig half loops, turn (9)

2) for the front half loops 9 sc, sl-st for the half loops of the wig, turn (9)

3) 6 sbn, 1 convex sbn, sbn, inc, ss for the half loops of the wig, turn (10)

4) 3 sbn, 1 concave sbn, 6 sbn, sl-st for half loops of the wig, turn (10)

5) 6 sc, 1 convex sc, 2 sc, inc, sl-st for half loops wig twist (11)

6) skip 3 sbn, knit for the front half loops, each we attach the column to the wig: 2 ss2n, 2 dc, psn, sbn, ss

The second row - 7 cells, alternate the next two schemes.

Scheme 1.

- 1) sbn, psn, ssn, 2 sbn down ssn, ss for half loops of the wig, turn (5)
- 2) for the front half-loops 5 sc, sl-st for the half-loops of the wig, turn (5)
- 3) 2 sbn, 1 convex sbn, sbn, inc, ss for the half loops of the wig, turn (6)
- 4) skip 3 sbn, knit for the front half loops, each we attach the column to the wig: ssn, psn, sbn

Scheme 2.

- 1) sbn, psn, 2 dc, 2 sb down dc, sl-st for half loops of the wig, turn (6)
- 2) for the front half loops 6 sc, sl-st for the half loops of the wig, turn (6)
- 3) 3 sbn, 1 convex sbn, sbn, inc, sl-st for half loops of the wig, turn (7)
- 4) skip 3 sbn, knit for the front half loops, each we attach the column to the wig: ss2n, ssn, psn, sbn

Third row, crown

- 1) dial 21 ch
- 2) in the 3rd air loop, knit 3 sc, (skip ch, in the next sl-st, skip ch, 3 sc in one) \* 4, skip ch, ss, turn
- 3) for the front half-loop (3 sc, sl-st) \* 5
- 4) fold in half lengthwise, sew. Through the received stretch the thread through the tube, pull it off slightly, sew it on the top of the head.



#### Registration

Sew the wig to the head. Embroider the mouth. Sew the head on body, first insert a pencil into the body and head or wire (they should run along the entire length of the body and head).

Eyes can be drawn on fabric, made from felt, foamiran, or use pre-made ones. Embroider eyebrows.

Fixies icon also can be drawn on fabric, embroidered, cut out of felt.
